5. **City Clerk** - requests Council approval of a contract between the NYS DEC and the City to allow the City Clerk's office to sell sporting/hunting licenses.

Resolutions:

Ordinances:

An ordinance amending Chapter 66-14, Animals which stipulates that dog owners must provide proof of liability insurance to cover accountability for the property where the dog is housed. No license shall be issued without said proof of insurance.
