## LACKAWANNA IS NOW SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING!!!!!!

Meaning: We Recycle Everything, Every Week  
Paper and Commingled can be put out to the curb at the same time!!

### Bulk Pickup

Spring Pickup - Week of March 28 - April 1 on your garbage day

Summer Pickup #1 - Week of May 23 -27 on your garbage day

Summer Pickup #2 - Week of July 25 - 29 on your garbage day

Fall Pickup - Week of October 24 - 28 on your garbage day

#### Bulk Items

Appliances:	Washers, Dryers, Refrigerators
Spring-made furniture:	Chairs, Couches, Mattresses / Box Springs
Large Furniture:	Dressers, Desks / Buffets, Scrap Metal

Grass and yard waste will be picked up with your garbage on your garbage day. Grass and yard waste must be put in separate open containers, CLEAR BAGS ONLY.

- Branches will be picked up from April 15 through October 15.
- All branches must be placed at curbside with cut ends facing the street
- Leaves will be picked up from mid-October through November (weather permitting).
- TIRES WILL NO LONGER BE PICKED UP BY THE CITY

ONE CUBIC YARD of debris will be accepted. Five bulk items (couch, chair, mattress, etc.) will be accepted. No construction material (drywall, 2x4's, windows, etc.) will be accepted. The homeowner, contractor or occupant is responsible for removing the debris. No sheds, fences, or decks will be accepted. Any person purchasing property within the City is responsible for any debris left behind by the previous occupant, as per Municipal Code, Section 190.7. All items must be placed at curbside by 7:00 am and **cannot** be put out the day before pickup.

Items cannot be put out earlier than 6 pm the day before your pickup and must be placed at curbside by 7 am on garbage day. No bags will be collected if it is outside of the tote, lid must be closed.

As per EPA rules, TV's and all other electronics will no longer be collected with garbage. Electronics must be dropped off at the 'City Garage' on Reddon St. between 8 am and 6 pm the week before Bulk Week, no exceptions. FIRE PITS and any open burning is prohibited by the City and subject to up a \$250.00 fine, as per Municipal Code Ch. 119).

**Anyone caught bringing in garbage from another community is considered ILLEGAL DUMPING and will be subject to a \$1000.00 fine per incident. If you see someone illegally dumping, please call the Lackawanna Police at: 822- 4900. Bringing in garbage from another community is considered illegal dumping, subject to a \$1000.00 fine.**

In addition to the scheduled bulk pick-up's listed, each resident is allowed to put out (1) bulk item the first FULL week of every month on their scheduled garbage day. If you forget to put the item out, you must wait until the following month, no exceptions.

May 2-6

June 6-10

July 4-8

August 1-5

September 5-9

October 3-7

November 7-11

December 5 - 9
