Ordinances:

1. An ordinance amending budget ordinance transferring \$20 from contingent account to Appraisals- Building & Equipment for Insurance value invoice.
2. An ordinance amending the budget decreasing A1410.101 by \$40,800 – Assistant Attorney and increasing A1420.101 Law, Personal Services for two (2) part time Assistant City Attorneys.
3. An ordinance to Chapter 155 of the Municipal Code entitled “Violations” replacing with various sections.
4. An ordinance amending Chapter 155 adding that unpaid violations, a lien against the property and the violations cost shall be added to the property owners taxes.
