

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

CITY OF LACKAWANNA, NEW YORK

Sealed bids for furnishing and delivery of materials to be incorporated into the project and to furnish all labor, equipment, and tools for the HAWK Signal Installation Project in the City of Lackawanna will be received by

the City of Lackawanna, the Owner, until Wednesday February 15th, 2017 at City Hall, 714 Ridge Road, Lackawanna, New York, 14218 until 10:45 AM local time and then at said office publicly read aloud at 11:00 AM in the City Council Chambers.

Copies of the proposed Contract Documents, Plans, Specifications and Instructions to Bidders may be examined at the City Clerk's Office and at the office of the Engineer, LaBella Associates, 300 Pearl Street, Suite 130, Buffalo, New York 14202. Copies may be secured from LaBella upon payment of \$50.00 per set of documents, which shall be in the form of two (2) checks each for one-half of the deposit. Checks shall be made payable to the City of Lackawanna.

The envelopes containing the bids must be sealed and addressed to City Clerks Office, City of Lackawanna, 714 Ridge Road, Lackawanna, New York, 14218 and must be designated as "HAWK Signal Installation Project".

Any bids not delivered in person shall be mailed to the City Clerk's Office, City of Lackawanna, 714 Ridge Road, Lackawanna, New York 14218.

Any bidder returning such Plans and Specifications in good condition within 30 days following the award of

the Contract or the rejection of the bids will be refunded the full amount of the deposit. Similarly non-bidders will be refunded one-half the deposit. Material suppliers and anyone returning the Plans and Specifications before the bid opening will also be classed as non-bidders. Any bidders requesting more than one (1) set of

plans and Specifications may purchase the excess, but it is understood that they are not returnable.

The City of Lackawanna is an exempt organization under the Tax law and is exempt from payment of Sales and Compensating Use Taxes on materials which are to be incorporated into the project and which are to be

separately sold by the Contractor to the Owner prior to incorporation into the project, pursuant to the provisions of the Contract. These taxes are not to be included in the bid.

The Owner reserves the right to waive any informality or to reject any or all bids.

Each bid must be accompanied by a non-collusive certification and a certified check of the bidder in the amount of 5% of the Bid (made payable to the Owner) or a bid bond prepared on the form of bid bond acceptable to the Owner, duly executed by the bidder as principal and having as surety thereon a surety company approved by the Owner in the amount of 5% of the bid. Such checks or bid bonds will be returned

to all except the three lowest bidders promptly after the opening of bids, and the remaining checks or bid bonds will be returned promptly after the Owner and the accepted bidder have executed the Contract, or if no award has been made within 45 days of the bid opening, upon demand of the bidder at any time thereafter,

so long as he has not been notified of the acceptance of his bid.

Attention of bidders is particularly called to the requirements as to the conditions of employment to be observed and minimum wage rates to be paid under the Contract.
